


Storytellers Hideaway Farm and Museum

Clement Railroad Hotel and Museum

The Clement Railroad Hotel Museum is one of the few remaining examples of a railroad hotel in a small Tennessee town. The hotel was built in 1913 in historic downtown Dickson, Tennessee. It features exhibits and programming involving the Civil War, railroading, and local and regional history. The Hotel Halbrook is a State of Tennessee Historical Commission's State Historic Sites, and is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

Montgomery Bell State Park



Montgomery Bell State Park has an abundance of historical, natural and cultural resources. The park offers camping, fishing, boating, hiking, picnicking, mountain biking, swimming and many other outdoor recreational activities. The park also boasts an award winning golf course; Golf Advisor Magazine (2019) ranked the 18-hole, par 72 course as the #3 golf course in the State of Tennessee.



Cumberland Furnace Historic District

Cumberland Furnace Historic District is a quiet hamlet with 22 historic structures related to the founding of the iron industry including Montgomery Bell's office, slave cabins and the original iron furnace site.



Promise Land Community

The Promise Land Community was established and settled during the Reconstruction Period (1870-1875) by former slaves from the nearby Cumberland Furnace. In 2007 the Promise Land School building was placed on the National Register of Historic Places. In 2010 a Civil War Trails Marker was placed on the school building.



HISTORY

Come explore the woven history of Dickson County! You can follow the DISCOVER TENNESSEE TRAILS & BYWAYS and see 8 Civil War sites and 20 National Register of Historic Place Sites.
